

Heritage College *Electronics Technology Program* obtains Canadian Forces accreditation

Gatineau, May 6, 2010 – On April 22, 2010, Heritage College’s *Electronics Technology Program* (number 243.11) was accredited by the Canadian Forces. “The accreditation of this Program will result in accelerated career opportunities for graduates who may be considering a career in the Canadian Forces” indicates the College’s Academic Dean, Jo Anne Werner. “This is a great opportunity to obtain advanced standing as Naval Electronics Technician and Naval Weapons Technician, for those interested in a career with the Canadian Navy”.

Students enrolled in this Program are eligible to receive a salary with benefits, as well as support to offset tuition and materials under certain enrollment conditions.

Heritage College’s *Electronics Technology Program* is one of eight career programs offered by the College. These programs include two components - general education courses and program-specific courses. Graduates of the three-year programs obtain a DEC diploma (Diplôme d’études collégiales).
